Dear Parent/Carer,

As we approach the end of the academic year I would like to share with you how we are supporting students back to school from September 2020 through our CORE Cares package.

CORE Cares is an entitlement package designed to give all students in CORE Education Trust schools a series of entitlements to ensure students are supported as they return to school in September 2020.

We expect all children to return to school in September, albeit with new arrangements in place. These arrangements will vary from school to school and families will be consulted on this with plenty of notice. Student well-being will remain fundamental in our plans to ensure a safe and smooth return to school.

CORE Cares is made up of a basic minimum entitlement of academic intervention; physical and emotional well-being programmes and access to value added enrichment opportunities. These will be brokered and supported through the Trust but managed and delivered locally. This entitlement may be complemented by other individual school initiatives, so does not constitute a totally definitive offer.

CORE Cares will be offered at two levels:

- Universal entitlement for every student
- Targeted entitlement for particular year groups

Universal Entitlement

Every student will have access to:

- Individual and small group tutoring in English, maths and science by specialist graduate mentors during school hours and after-school
- The CORE Leaders of Tomorrow programme (the first cohort will continue into the next academic year)
- The Echo Eternal creative arts project
- A laptop and data to access online learning where/when required for any distance and/or online learning.

Targeted Entitlement

Additionally, every new Year 7 student will additionally be entitled to:

- The Mind Safe programme <https://www.mind-safe.com/Login>, a resilience and well-being programme.

Additionally, every Year 10 student going into Year 11 will be entitled to:

- Targeted tutoring intervention support through MyTutor www.mytutor.co.uk

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- The CORE Extra Online lessons, led by our best subject specialists (these will continue to run for the whole of the next academic year at least)
- After school and school holiday support throughout the academic year
- Access to a specially constructed curriculum and well being portal

Additionally, some Year 10 students going into Year 11 will be entitled to:

- A bespoke development programme through our partners at Digital Innovators

Additionally, every year 11 who has now left the Academy will be entitled to:

Access to the Zero Gravity mentoring scheme www.zerogravity.co.uk

Over the summer holiday, August 2020:

Years 7-10 students will be eligible to apply to a summer camp event hosted at City Academy. Transport and meals will be provided. Details how to apply will be sent separately. Every student will also receive a home digital summer learning pack.
